→ **Barnlandet.** A modern family circus show with playful, physical comedy set in children's everyday environment: the sandbox.

20:00 SANNEX

→ **Dansbanan.** The Swedish genre "dansband" is primarily inspired by swing, schlager, country and jazz. This award-winning band always puts in effort to create a memorable evening full of dance. Second set at 22:00, third at 00:00. Until 00:45.

22:00 MOVIE: IN I DIMMAN

→ **Manegen.** Maciej Kalymon's unique portrayal of the lonely shadow figures of Malmö takes us on a hypnotic journey into the mist, where intoxication is the cure for darkness.

23:00 AGGREGAT

→ **Malmöscenen.** Boy Santiago and Monty Party wraps up Eight of Cups Records evening with an electric mix of dub, techno, house, minimal, acid, and some old classics.

→ **Stora Scenen.** Lebanese Samaha is an internationally acclaimed pop artist well established in the Middle East.

→ **Stora Scenen.** Their hypnotic blend of psychedelic rock, prog influences, and incredibly strong pop melodies has attracted music lovers for almost 10 years.

→ **Barnlandet.** Challenge your engineering skills and creativity by building with modules from the studio Collective Paper Aesthetics. Until 18:00.

17:00 ORCHESTRA BAOBAB (SN)

→ **Stora Scenen.** This epic story began in the late 1960s, in the heart of Dakar. Their fusion of Afro-Latin style, tropical club vibes, griot, and pop has conquered the world!

18:30 KRASHKARMA (US)

→ **Rock Stage.** The most daring duo of the metal genre. With Niki Skistimas on lead vocals and drums, and co-vocalist Ralf Dieter on Frankenstein bass guitar. Energetic, immense, and vibrant.

→ **Stora Scenen.** The world-famous Swedish singer-songwriter with a Dylan-esque voice draws great inspiration from American tradition.

→ **Stora Scenen.** This young rapper mixes samples from TLC with Swedish ballads into greatness to tell his stories. His collaboration with Stormzy speaks volumes.

19:00 ANA TIJOUX (CL/FR)

→ **Stora Scenen.** The hip-hop artist and activist has been selected the best Spanish-speaking rapper by Rolling Stones and has been described as a Latin American Lauryn Hill.

21:00 OTTO KNOWS

→ **Stora Scenen.** Feel your pulse rises to the limit when the Swedish house star mixes hits like "Million Voices," "Parachute," and his latest single "Be Somebody."

22:00 JOSHUA IDEHEN (UK/SE)

→ **Manegen.** An English-born Nigerian artist, now residing in Sweden, where he, together with Ludvig Parment, creates a unique mix of lo-fi house, gospel, and poetry.

→ **Gatuscenen.** Xochipilli Mexican Cultural Association, together with university students from Mexico, offers a dance show with folk dance and live Mariachi music.

→ **St. Petri Church.** A legend of electronic music, who has toured the world with his nature-inspired electronic music for over 25 years, presents an ambient set. Co-organized by: Kontra-musik. Until 22:30.

21:00 JIREEL

→ **Stora Scenen.** The rapper, singer, and songwriter from Stockholm has received awards, platinum records, and over 250 million streams since his debut in 2016.

23:00 MISS LI

→ **Stora Scenen.** One of the most beloved pop artists of Sweden will end Malmöfestivalen 2023 with a bang! Capturing the audience with power, playfulness, and pure stage presence she is a true modern queen of Swedish pop.
